

## Regional small businesses assistance and grants now available

Washington Retail is pleased to share several new assistance and grants that target that a disproportionately impacted by COVID businesses.

Washington State Department of Commerce (Commerce) received a \$15 million grant from the U.S. Economic Development Administration to support collaboration among public, private and philanthropic organizations to support small businesses.

<u>Press release</u> from Commerce specified that this grant will support Safe Start projects and partnerships aimed at help small business restart, rebuild and become more resilient. Grant money will benefit various regional economic development partnerships. For example, the Thurston County Economic Development Council received \$182,000 to operate a one year program through their Center for Business & Innovation to support entrepreneurs, business growth and excellence.

To reach ethnic businesses, Commerce offered funding to over 20 organizations to offer <u>technical assistance</u> aimed at reaching culturally and linguistically challenged business owner and organizations.
